**Early Bird Entries close May 8, 2026**

**Entry information:** Classes are open to horses registered with the AMHA for rated classes, or unregistered horses 38" and under for the Non-rated classes. The official show rules of the American Miniature Horse Association will apply except for 4H / Youth Jumper and 4H / Youth Showmanship (see rules below). All 4H classes are open to any youth exhibitor. The AMHA Rule Book can be found online at: [www.amha.org](http://www.amha.org)

All AMHA entries in this show must be accompanied by a photocopy (front & back) of the horse registration papers and copies of Amateur/Youth cards. AMHA membership and Amateur/Youth card applications will be available at the show **for an additional charge.**

Judges Evaluation Cards will be available in the Show Office and are completed on a voluntary basis.

All Exhibitors are welcome to participate in all shows regardless of physical or mental limitations.

Gelding status must be reflected on the papers or a show letter from the office must be provided.

**Parking:** Truck and horse trailer parking is in the dirt lot east of the Indoor Arena at the Fairgrounds.

**Stalls:** Covered outdoor stalls for exhibitors arriving Friday 5/22/2026 after 12:00 PM – Sunday 5/24/2026 at the end the show. **Bring your own bedding.** Maximum of 2 horses per stall. If more than 2 horses are found in a stall at any time during the show, an additional fee of \$30 per horse/per day will be charged. Exhibitors may show out of their trailer for a fee of \$30.00 per horse. **(This does not include the Dry Camping Fee)**

**Measuring:** Horses must be measured before they enter the show ring. Measurement times: **Friday 5/22/2026** 5:30-6:30 pm (approx. time) / **Saturday 5/23/2026** & **Sunday 5/24/26 8:00-8:30 AM**

**Recreational Vehicles:** Campgrounds are available on sight for an additional fee payable directly to the Fairgrounds. Go to <https://www.bouldercounty.org/open-space/fairgrounds/campground/> for more information.

**Dry Camping** is allowed in the dirt area east of the Indoor Arena. Fee is \$10.00 per night. Camping Pass will be available in the Show Office. Cash payments ONLY due when you check in at the show office.

**Out of State Horses** - Horses must be accompanied by an official health certificate dated no more than 30 days from time of arrival & a NEGATIVE test for Equine Infectious Anemia (AGID/Coggins Test) within 12 months of the date of the show.

Each exhibitor will be liable for injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned, exhibited by, or in his/her custody or control, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the American Miniature Horse Association, the Boulder County Fairgrounds, the Rocky Mountain Miniature Horse Club and the Show Management from and against all claims, demands, cause of action, costs, charges, and expenses of every kind and nature arising out of or which may be incurred by reason of any accident, injury, or damage to person or property caused by the ownership, exhibition, custody, or control of horses exhibited. **Presentation of signed entry blanks shall be deemed acceptance of these rules, and in the event of failure to sign the entry, the first entry into the show ring as an exhibitor or first entry of an animal owned by an individual shall be deemed to be an acceptance of said rules.**

#### **Hardship Opportunity**

There will be an AMHA Director or Show Steward and an AMHA Judge available after the last class of the show on Friday, 5/23/2025 to hardship eligible horses into the AMHA. Horses must be 36 months of age or greater and measure 34" or under. See the current AMHA Rule Book for complete rules and guidelines. Exhibitors must contact the Show Manager prior to the show to make arrangements.

#### **Directions:**

The Boulder County Fairgrounds is located at 9595 Nelson Rd. Longmont, CO 80501. From I-25 take the HWY 119 (Exit 240) west toward Longmont for 7.8 miles. Turn right on Nelson Rd and the Fairgrounds will be on your right approximately 1/2 mile.

## Rules for 4H / Youth Jumpers & 4H / Youth Showmanship (Non-rated classes)

### 4H / Youth Jumpers:

4H Youth Jumpers are scored mathematically on accumulated faults, and on time to complete the course in case of ties. There will be one round which will be both scored for faults and timed. Exhibitors will be placed in order of least faults to most faults, with time utilized to break any ties (i.e. scoring by faults and then by time). There will be no additional rounds.

Each exhibitor will be timed by the Steward with a stopwatch or by automatic timer. If timed by the steward, the steward must be aligned with the start/finish cones and must time all exhibitors in a class from the same position. Timing starts when the horse's nose passes the starting line and finishes when the horse's nose passes the finish line.

a) Faults:

- Knockdowns – an obstacle is considered knocked down when a horse or handler, by contact, lowers the established height of the fence in any way – 4 faults.
- Refusals – stopping at an obstacle without knocking it down and without backing, followed by jumping from a standstill is not penalized. However, if the halt continues or if the horse backs even a single step, side steps or circle to retake the fence, a refusal is incurred:
  - 1st refusal – 4 Faults
  - 2nd refusal – 4 Faults
  - 3rd refusal – Disqualification
- Circling – any form of circle or circles whereby the horse crosses its original track between two consecutive obstacles, stops advancing toward the next obstacle, or turn away from the next obstacle, except to retake an obstacle after a disobedience. Crossing your own path (i.e. circling between fences, NOT retaking a fence from a refusal) – 3 Faults

### 4H / Youth Showmanship:

4H Youth Showmanship Exhibitor is to show his/her horse to the presiding (call) Judge only. The half system is used when exhibiting your horse.

# **Boulder County Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement**

## **2026 Adult Form**

For purposes of this agreement the term "Boulder County Fairgrounds" shall mean the entire Fairgrounds property including any and all facilities thereon (by way of example but without limitation, the Indoor Arena and the Outdoor Arena).
