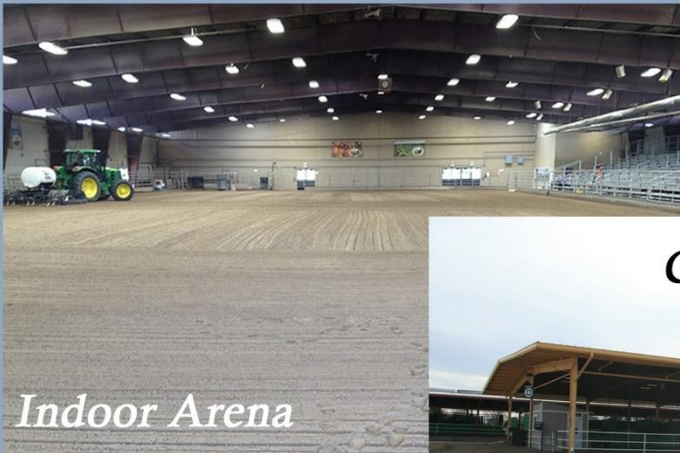

Entry information: Classes are open to horses registered with the AMHA for rated classes, or unregistered horses 38" and under for the Non-rated classes. The official show rules of the American Miniature Horse Association will apply. The AMHA Rule Book can be found online at: www.amha.org

All AMHA entries in this show must be accompanied by a photocopy (front & back) of the horse registration papers and copies of Amateur/Youth cards. AMHA membership and Amateur/Youth card applications will be available at the show **for an additional charge.**

Judges Evaluation Cards will be available in the Show Office and are completed on a voluntary basis.

All Exhibitors are welcome to participate in all shows regardless of physical or mental limitations.

Gelding status must be reflected on the papers or a show letter from the office must be provided.

Awards: 1st - 6th Place – Ribbons | Grand & Reserve Champions – Ribbons | Open Supreme – Sash & Award

Parking: Truck and horse trailer parking is in the dirt lot east of the Indoor Arena at the Fairgrounds.

Stalls: Covered outdoor stalls for exhibitors arriving Thursday 5/21/2026 after 1:00 PM – Friday 5/22/2026 at the end the show. **Bring your own bedding.** Maximum of 2 horses per stall. If more than 2 horses are found in a stall at any time during the show, an additional fee of \$30 per horse will be charged.

Exhibitors may show out of their trailer for a fee of \$15.00 per horse. **(This does not include the Dry Camping Fee).** Please contact the show manager to make any special arrangements.

Measuring: Horses must be measured before they enter the show ring. Measurement times: **Thursday 5/21/2026** TBA–5:30 / **Friday 5/22/2026** 7:30-8:30 AM

Recreational Vehicles: Campgrounds are available on sight for an additional fee payable directly to the Fairgrounds. Go to <https://www.bouldercounty.org/open-space/fairgrounds/campground/> for more information.

Dry Camping is allowed in the dirt area east of the Indoor Arena. Fee is \$10.00 per night. Camping Pass will be available in the Show Office. Cash payments ONLY due when you check in at the show office.

Out of State Horses - Horses must be accompanied by an official health certificate dated no more than 30 days from time of arrival & a NEGATIVE test for Equine Infectious Anemia (AGID/Coggins Test) within 12 months of the date of the show.

Each exhibitor will be liable for injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned, exhibited by, or in his/her custody or control, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the American Miniature Horse Association, the Boulder County Fairgrounds, the Rocky Mountain Miniature Horse Club and the Show Management from and against all claims, demands, cause of action, costs, charges, and expenses of every kind and nature arising out of or which may be incurred by reason of any accident, injury, or damage to person or property caused by the ownership, exhibition, custody, or control of horses exhibited. **Presentation of signed entry blanks shall be deemed acceptance of these rules, and in the event of failure to sign the entry, the first entry into the show ring as an exhibitor or first entry of an animal owned by an individual shall be deemed to be an acceptance of said rules.**

Hardship Opportunity

There will be an AMHA Director or Show Steward and an AMHA Judge available after the last class of the show on Friday, 5/22/2026 to hardship eligible horses into the AMHA. Horses must be 36 months of age or greater and measure 34" or under. See the current AMHA Rule Book for complete rules and guidelines. Exhibitors must contact the Show Manager prior to the show to make arrangements.

Waiver: I am voluntarily using the Boulder County Fairgrounds for equine activities. In consideration of the opportunity to use the Boulder County Fairgrounds, I, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives or assigns, agree to be solely responsible for and **do hereby release, waive discharge and covenant not to sue** Boulder County (the “Landlord”), its elected and appointed officials, and its employees, agents and representatives, for any and all claims resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death) to myself or my animal/s or third parties or their animals which may in whole or in part be caused by my use of the Boulder County Fairgrounds, or which may result or arise in whole or in part from my use of the Boulder County Fairgrounds, whether caused by my negligence or otherwise.

Assumption of the Risk: I understand and acknowledge that the use, handling and riding of a horse, (including, activities that involve other animals such as, without limitation, team-roping) involves risk of physical injury to any individual undertaking such activities; and that a horse, and any other animals involved in such activities, irrespective of its/their training and usual past behavior and characteristics, may act or react unpredictably at times based upon instinct, fright or unfamiliar surroundings (for example by not as a limitation, the Boulder County Fairgrounds or being around other animals) which, likewise, is an inherent risk. I hereby assert that my use of the Boulder County Fairgrounds is voluntary and that **I knowingly assume all such risks.**

I have read and understand the following:

UNDER COLORADO LAW AN EQUINE PROFESSIONAL/EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES, PURSUANT TO C.R.S., § 13-21-119, AS AMENDED.
